**How do we develop mathematical talent?
An American perspective in light of the
National Mathematics Advisory Panel report**

In this lecture, an overview of the state of mathematics talent development in the U.S will be provided. The role of political, cultural and curricular forces on how mathematics content is delivered for gifted and talented students in the U.S will be addressed. The lecture will also address issues (and biases) related to (a) eastern versus western models of talent development (b) the construct of mathematical intelligence, (c) the identification of mathematically talented students among minorities and second language learners, (d) effective and ineffective intra and extra-curricular programming and techniques, and (e) talent development in light of the National Mathematics Advisory Panel report.

Zur Biographie:

Bharath Sriraman is Full Professor of Mathematics in the Department of Mathematical Sciences and is also Faculty of Central/SW Asian Studies at The University of Montana, with a wide range of eclectic research interests. He lives in Montana by way of the merchant marine; Alaska (B.S in mathematics, University of Alaska- Fairbanks) and Northern Illinois (M.S & PhD in mathematics, minor in mathematics education). Among his myriad research interests are mathematical creativity; innovation and talent development, in relation to which he serves on the editorial boards of Gifted Child Quarterly, Roeper Review, High Ability Studies and Journal of Advanced Academics. He was an Associate Editor of The Encyclopedia of Giftedness, Creativity and Talent currently in press at Sage Publications. He has published over 200 journal articles, commentaries, book chapters, edited books and reviews in his areas of interest, and presented over 100 lectures at international conferences, symposia and invited colloquia in 23 countries. He was most recently named as an Outstanding Faculty Member at The University of Montana in the 2008 Presidents Report "Standing Out".
